

**GARFIELD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING
MAY 26, 2015 AT 10:00 A.M.**

Present: Commissioner Del LeFevre , Commissioner David Tebbs, Attorney Barry Huntington and Clerk Camille Moore. Commissioner Leland Pollock was excused.

Commissioner LeFevre called the meeting to order.

Commissioner David Tebbs made a MOTION to adopt the agenda. Seconded by Commissioner Dell LeFevre. Motion carried. Voting unanimous.

Commissioner David Tebbs made a MOTION to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2015. Seconded by Commissioner Dell LeFevre. Motion carried. Voting unanimous.

BOARD REPORTS

Commissioner David Tebbs reported on the controlled burn meeting in Tropic with the federal agencies. He also reported on the Planning Commission meeting and the ribbon cutting at Kodachrome State Park.

Commissioner Del LeFevre reported on the Western Interstate Region Conference he attended in Hawaii.

PLANNING DEPARTMENT BUSINESS

Justin Fischer, Planner, gave the Commission an overview of a proposal to amend a subdivision at Panguitch Lake.

SHERIFF'S OFFICE PERSONNEL - ESCALANTE CITY POLICE

Sheriff Danny Perkins and Mayor Jerry Taylor, Stephanie Steed, Recorder, Escalante City were present. Mayor Taylor reported the Escalante Town Council has voted to enter a contract with the County to provide law enforcement. After discussion, Commissioner Tebbs made a MOTION to approve providing law enforcement to Escalante Town. One deputy will be

provided and Escalante City will pay \$55,000.00 per year to offset the cost. The Commission gave Sheriff Perkin's authorization to proceed with the hiring process. Seconded by Commissioner Lefevre. Motion carried. Voting unanimous.

COUNTY FIRE FUNDING REQUEST

Ron Harris, County Fire Chief's Association, made a request to purchase battery packs and chargers for the gas detectors that were purchased a year ago. After discussion, Commissioner Tebbs made a MOTION to approve the purchase for a cost of approximately \$1,100.00 (\$135.00 per unit). Seconded by Commissioner LeFevre. Motion carried.

BEER LICENSE APPLICATION

An application has been received from Red Canyon Village LLC for a Class "B" Beer License. After review, Commissioner Tebbs made a MOTION to issue a Class "B" Beer License to Red Canyon Village LLC. Seconded by Commissioner LeFevre. Motion carried. Voting unanimous.
