

**GARFIELD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING
AUGUST 10, 2015 AT 10:00 A.M.**

Present: Commissioner Dell LeFevre, Commissioner Leland Pollock, Commissioner David Tebbs and Clerk Camille Moore. Attorney Barry Huntington was excused.

Commissioner Pollock called the meeting to order.

Commissioner David Tebbs made a MOTION to adopt the agenda. Seconded by Commissioner Dell LeFevre. Motion carried. Voting unanimous.
