

# Garfield County Fair 2016

## GENERAL RULES

1. Enter exhibits (Home Arts, Fine Art, 4-H) on, **Wednesday, August 17, 2016** from 10 am – 6 pm @ Triple C Arena. Items brought after deadline will be for display only. Enter all Fruits, Vegetables and Flowers on, **Thursday, August 18, 2016** from 8:00 am – 9:30 am @ Triple C Arena. CHECK INDIVIDUAL DEPARTMENT RULES.
2. Articles should not have been entered previously in any County Fair except for display only.
3. Entries to be judged are limited to exhibitors residing in Garfield County.
4. Entries by non-residents will be for display only and will not be judged.
5. All entries entered for judging, must be the work of the exhibitor, and shown in his or her name. All articles must be complete.
6. Upon registration, all exhibits will be under the custody of the fair organization until they are officially released to their owners or community representatives.
7. The fair committee with the assistance of volunteers will use diligence to care for all property placed in its charge, but the fair organization will not assume any responsibility for injury or loss for any cause.
8. Any questions on the part of exhibitors or judges, not covered by these rules, will be subject to Utah State Fair rules. All decisions of the judges will be final.
9. Cash premiums will be paid: Sweepstakes Ribbon = \$20; Special Award Ribbon = \$10; Blue Ribbon = \$4; Red Ribbon = \$2; White/Participation Ribbon = \$1; 4-H Cloverbud Participation = \$4.
10. Exhibits may **ONLY** be picked up from the Fair building on Saturday after the Talent Show, approximately 5 p.m. If you are unavailable, please designate someone for pickup on entry form  
All exhibitors will receive a t-shirt (per exhibitor) and chance (per exhibit) for the grand prize drawings. Note: must be present at talent show to win grand prizes.

### **4-H Exhibits**

1. The following are requirements for 4-H member participation.
  - 4-H members must have been in the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade through the 12<sup>th</sup> grade on Oct 1, 2015 of the exhibit year. Pre 4-H (Cloverbuds: K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade) are also eligible to exhibit. Cloverbud exhibits are awarded a premium of \$4 per exhibit for participation only.
  - **4-H members must be enrolled in the project in which the exhibit is entered by August 1, 2016.**
  - Disabled and special needs adult members are eligible to enroll in 4-H and to exhibit in the 4-H department at the county fair. These exhibits may be eligible for the state fair.
  - 4-H members will be allowed to enter no more than **one exhibit per lot**. Exceptions to this rule are Food Preservation (3 bottles of different fruit and three bottles of different vegetables are allowed) Additional items can be entered in Open Division.

2. The following are guidelines and information for exhibits:

- Exhibits eligible for the State Fair need to be at the Extension Office Monday, August 29, 2016 by noon. Exhibits receiving an “Eligible for State Fair” sticker can either be left or taken home for cleaning and remake (i.e. baked goods) and then brought to the Extension Office by the above date and time. Baked goods can also be frozen when made for the county fair and used for the State Fair if they win. Items taken to the State Fair will be available for pick up after September 21, 2016 at the Garfield County Extension Office. #### **CLASS BCA – ARTS AND CRAFTS**

An item created utilizing one of the following crafts:

BEADING, CERAMICS, PORCELAIN, FLOWER ARRANGING, LEATHER CRAFT, PAPER CRAFT, FABRIC CRAFT, METAL, TILE PICTURES , PLASTIC CANVAS, WOOD CARVING/ENGRAVING, PAINTED WOOD CRAFTS, VINYL LETTERING, WAX CRAFTS, SCRAPBOOKING, PERSONAL CARE ITEMS, BUILDING BLOCKS, MODEL CARS, JEWELRY, OTHER

#### **CLASS BCB – DRAWING, PAINTING SCULPTURE**

#### **CLASS BCD – PHOTOGRAPHY *-All photography should be mounted or framed.***

Lot 1: One photo album page attractively displaying **photos taken by you** in your project. (Judging will be on the pictures, not on the scrapbooking.)

Lot 2: A photo story. About 5 to 10 black and white or color pictures which depict a simple story.

An enlarged 4x6, 5x7 or 8x10 mounted and titled color or black and white photograph

Landscape – Color or Black & White

Person Portrait, Animal – Wildlife or Pets, Sports/Action, Human Interest, Macro / Close-Up, Single Flower or Flowers, Architecture, Abstract, 4-H Promotional Photo – (ie projects, community service, activities/events), Conventional photo using adjustable focus and or adjustable exposure. Negative must be included.

Digitally Altered or Enhanced Photo – should include original photo for comparison

Group of related photos (3 to 5 photos); Group of unrelated photos (3 to 5 photos) or Other- a photography item that is NOT mentioned in the Photography classes above. Items might include video, movie making, animation, color enhancement, etc.

**CLASS CA - CHILD DEVELOPMENT, CHILD CARE, BABYSITTING**

**CLASS CB - SEWING CONSTRUCTION, QUILTING, KNITTING, CROCHET, NEEDLECRAFT/KNOT TYING, SPINNING AND WEAVING, INTERIOR DESIGN**

Poster, notebook or display of what was learned.

### **CLASS EC - FOODS and NUTRITION**

**CLASS ECC - FOOD PRESERVATION:** Completed label on lower side of jar to include the information listed in the general Fair Exhibit “Canning” rules.

### **CLASS ECD - FOOD PREPARATION**

*Food items must not require refrigeration. Must include recipe.*

Four baked or bar cookies, muffins or brownies

A square, oblong or round layer cake without frosting

Invented snack

Four pieces of candy

A single or double crust baked fruit pie

International/ethnic food product or educational display

Notebook for catered meal (e.g., quick meal or meal preparation notebooks)

Table setting and centerpiece for special occasion (For county fair use only)

Any other food preparation item or educational display

### **CLASS ECDB – BREADS**

One loaf Quick bread; White bread; International bread; or Specialty grain (whole wheat, rye, oat), traditional or machine

Four pretzels, baking powder biscuits or breadsticks or yeast rolls (not a sweet roll)

Sweet yeast bread or four sweet rolls

Creative bread/Bread sculpture - one display, use of a bread machine or purchased frozen dough optional
