

JOB DESCRIPTION

A. NAME AND TITLE: Canyonlands Weed Specialist.

B. LOCATION: Mainly Escalante Watershed and other portions of Garfield County.

C. RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Spray noxious weeds where needed in Garfield County.
2. Work with private landowners in identifying weed problems and mitigating controls.
3. Map existing weed populations and monitor control methods.
4. Coordinate with the weed board on a regular basis.
5. Mix potentially hazardous chemicals and apply in accordance with local, state and federal laws.
6. Participate in weed awareness activities and attend weed educational workshops/meetings.

D. RELATIONSHIPS:

1. Weed Supervisor.
2. Responsible to Canyonlands Conservation District/Weed Board for direction, guidance and supervision.
3. The Canyonlands Weed Board Reports to the Garfield County Commission.

E. QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Ability to communicate and work effectively with farmers, ranchers, private landowners, and government agency personnel.
2. Must have or be able to obtain a Utah Commercial Pesticide Applicator License and appropriate endorsements.
3. Must be flexible in work schedule.
4. Must be able to read chemical labels and follow directions.
5. Must be self motivated.
6. Must have and maintain a current drivers license.
7. Preference will be given to persons with knowledge of GPS and Digital Cameras.

F. WAGE AND TIME COMMITMENT:

1. \$12.34/hr., Promotion upon completion of a Utah Pesticide Applicators License.
2. Part-time, 5-6 months/year average 30-40 hours per week.
