

JUNE 26, 2018 PRIMARY ELECTION

The Election will be conducted **BY MAIL**. Please be aware that on Election Day there will be **NO POLLING PLACE** in your precinct.

There is one Non-Partisan race for the Garfield County School Board District #4 (**Bryce Canyon City, Cannonville, Henrieville and Tropic**) The Republican Party has one race countywide, for those affiliated with the Republican Party.

By-mail ballots will be mailed on **June 5, 2018**. Registered voters affiliated with the Republican Party or in School Board District #4 who have not received their ballot by **Thursday, June 14th**, should contact the Garfield County Clerk's Office.

EARLY VOTING For voters wishing to vote in person, Voting Machines will be available at the Clerk's Office **Monday, June 18th through Friday, June 22nd from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.**

The Clerk's Office will be open and Voting Machines will be available on **Election Day, June 26th from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.**

You may return your voted ballot by mail. Ballots must be **postmarked** by the day before the election (**June 25, 2018**). **OR**

You may drop off your ballot in person at the County Clerk's Office, 55 South Main Street, Panguitch, Monday - Friday 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. through election day, Tuesday, June 26, 2018. On **Election Day** the Clerk's Office will be open from **7:00 am to 8:00 pm.**

Voter Registration Deadlines: You may register to vote in person at the County Clerk's Office or online until **Tuesday, June 19, 2018.**

A demonstration of the **Logic and Accuracy Testing** of voter equipment will be conducted on **June 11, 2018** at 3:30 pm in the Clerk's Office.
